## Attendance

* Our building goal is 93\% attendance
* Attendance will be carefully tracked. If your child's attendance is a concern, you will be communicated to by one of us. * After 10 excused days (following attendance procedures) a Dr.'s note will be required for an absence to be excused


## Attendance

* If at any time your child is absent - you must call the attendance line (found on website) - not following attendance procedures could result in an unexcused absence.
* It is always good practice to provide a medical excuse note when your child is ill, or at an appt. and they miss school.


## Attendance

* If your child is tardy to school - check-in at

Welcome Center and get a pass to first period
(once 3 tardies to school are achieved - a detention is earned ; starts over each quarter)

* Student leaving for an appt.
* Call Welcome Center, or provide a note to the Welcome Center and you child will receive a pass to leave the building (Your child can meet you at your vehicle by the curb).
